

ORDINANCE NO. 80 AMENDMENT NO. 2

AN AMMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 80, TO ADDRESS AND LIMIT THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITIN THE GEO-POLITICAL BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAPLE RAPIDS CONSISTENT WITH THE STATE LAWS GOVRNING FIREWORKS

THE VILLAGEE OF MAPLE RAPIDS ORDAINS:

That thee following sections shall be modified as shown below

Section 2. Illegal Use of Fireworks

(b) No person shall ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks except as defined in the Michigan Fireworks Safety Act (MCL 28,457 et seg):

- i. December 31 until 1 a.m. on January 1
- ii. The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day until 11:45 p.m.
on each of those days.
- iii. June 29 to July 4 until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
- iv. July 5, if that date is a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 p.m.
- v. The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day until 11:45 p.m.
on each of those days.
- vi. on public or school property, without the express, written permission of the
Village Council granting such permission to do so; or
- vii. on church property or the property f another, without express permission from
the property owner(s);

Section 3. Penalty for a Violation of Fireworks Ordinance

(b) A person in violation of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a \$1000.00 fine for each violation, \$500 of the fine collected under this ordinance shall be remitted to the local law enforcement agency responsible for enforcing the ordinance.






