

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 37 PASSED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAPLE RAPIDS, MICHIGAN ON JUNE 18, 1970, ORDINANCE NO. 39 PASSED ON APRIL 29, 1971, ORDINANCE 41 PASSED ON JANUARY 5, 1972, AND ORDINANCE NO. 75 PASSED ON DECEMBER 4, 2006 TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE CLINTON COUNTY SANITARY SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM NO.2 (VILLAGE OF MAPLE RAPIDS) ON A PUBLIC UTILITY BASIS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ACT. 94, PUBLIC ACTS OF MICHIGAN 933 AS AMENDED.

THE VILLAGE OF MAPLE RAPIDS ORDAINS:

Section 4. Rates to be charged for service furnished by the System shall be as follows:

SEWER USE CHARGES

Sewer use charges to each single-family residential premises served by the System shall be in the flat amount of \$64 per quarter. Beginning January 1, 2019, the rates shall increase by \$3 per quarter per year through the year 2029. Municipal billing fees will be assessed for each applicable address. Any sewer services outside of the Village Limits shall be billed at 150% of the Village Rates. Residents that reside part of the year out of state (Snow Birds) may freeze their service as long as prior arrangements are made with the Village Clerk

Each premises other than a single-family residence shall pay the above monthly charge multiplied by the number of units.

TAP CHARGES

Sewer Tap charge rates shall be \$2,500 for the tap into the existing sewer line or to cap an existing sewer line. An additional \$1000 will be charged for each road cut. Extensions of existing sewer lines will be paid for by the affected customer. All work not performed by the Village of Maple Rapids DPW shall be performed by a bonded and insured contractor.

Section 6.

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause, or provisions shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All Ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its passage by the Village Council.






