

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL
MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS IN
THE VILLAGE OF MAPLE RAPIDS

THE VILLAGE OF MAPLE RAPIDS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 86 is enacted by the Village of Maple Rapids as follows:

Section 2. Pursuant to the authority provided by Michigan General Law Village Act, section 62.1, the Village of Maple Rapids hereby ordains:

- A. PURPOSE: The purpose of this ordinance and chapter is to exercise the Village of Maple Rapids' authority to prohibit the establishment or operation of marihuana establishments within the Village limits as such establishments or facilities are defined in the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (the "ACT");
- B. PROHIBITION: Pursuant to the Act, Section 6.1, which addresses the legality of recreational marihuana in the State of Michigan (Proposition 1, the Marihuana Legalization Initiative of 2018), the Village of Maple Rapids prohibits the establishment or operation of any and all categories of marihuana establishments and facilities within its geo-political boundaries.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be effective immediately due to the need to protect public health, safety, welfare and the orderly administration of affairs of the Village of Maple Rapids.


The above Ordinance was moved by Council person Bill Schmidt and supported by Council person Paul Sorah at a regularly scheduled meeting on August 7, 2019.


